

Mission Trip Application Packet
Memphis, TN
Saturday, June 22 – Friday, June 28

Applications must be submitted by **Sunday, May 5, 2019**

For this year's mission trip, we will be going to Memphis, TN. The Memphis area is one of the most impoverished areas in the country. 27% of people live below the national poverty level. It is a city that needs to see and experience the love of Christ. In order for us to share the love of Christ with this city we will be partnering with local churches and mission organizations, where we will be use 5 main areas of ministry.

Ministry Opportunities:

Each participant will choose to share Christ through one of the following areas:

- Sports Camp
- Children's Ministry
- Construction
- Block Parties
- Cook Team

Guidelines:

- Mission trip is open to all FBCP members who have completed the 6th grade. A parent or responsible adult must participate with all sixth graders. Children in 5th grade or younger are not permitted to participate.
- All adults are expected to function as chaperones for the youth. This is especially important during the Community Events.
- All short-term missionaries need to participate fully in Sunday School, worship, and discipleship activities, plus ALL planning/training meetings.

Registration Process

1. Complete the registration envelope and mission trip fund request form.
2. Turn forms in with \$75 payment by May 5th
3. A personal interview may be required at the discretion of the Team Leader.
4. Adults - A background check, if one has not been completed by First Baptist Church of Pelham.

Qualifications

Mission participation is open to all FBC Pelham members in good standing. Participation from members of other churches will be determined by the team leader. FBCP members will be given first priority for placement on the team.

Responsibilities

Upon approval of the application, it should be understood that all prospective team members will be responsible for the following:

1. To review, understand and comply with all FBCP policies and procedures regarding short-term mission trips as provided during the pre-trip training meetings.
2. To fully abstain from the use of alcohol, recreational drugs, and/or tobacco in any form, and any use of inappropriate language while on the mission trip including travel to and from the field.
3. To attend all pre-trip team training meetings and complete all assignments as given by the respective team leader.
4. To be flexible and willingly submit to the assigned team leader and field personnel.
